PRIMARY PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this position is to provide in-home services for children that have been abused and/or neglected.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Provides family based social work services designed to strengthen and empower families while ensuring the safety of children in cases in which abuse, neglect and/or dependency have been alleged or found. Primarily this will be provided through in home services and treatment. This position will routinely be required to serve as back-up for the afterhours social workers. The employee will be required to attend court and submit court reports. If the agency is given custody of the child by the court the social worker will be expected to continue to provide social work services until the child achieves safety and permanence.

ADDITIONAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Shelter management in times of emergency situations. Must be able to lift small children. Bilingual (Spanish) a plus.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Master's Degree from an accredited school of social work and one year of social work experience; or a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited school of social work and two years of social work or counseling experience; or a Master's degree in a counseling field and two years of social work or counseling experience; or a four year degree in a human services field or related curriculum and three years of social work or counseling experience; or graduation from a four-year college or university and four years of experience in rehabilitation counseling, pastoral counseling, or a related human service field providing experience in the techniques of casework, group work, or community organization; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. One year of work experience can be credited for completion of the social work collaborative. Social worker will be expected to complete 24 hours of continuing education per year.
