

The NBAMPO Draft scoring for the Division Needs Projects was calculated by applying the methodology approved by the TAC on April 24, 2014. The MPO deviated from the approved methodology by allocating 100 points to ALL Division Need Projects to emphasize the need and support for local projects. The NBAMPO was allocated a total of 1100 points to assign to the projects in this category. The Airport Director and member of the NBAMPO TCC elected to select only the top 3 projects from the original list of Aviation Projects, as the MPO did not have enough points to adequately score all projects and the North Carolina Department of Aviation has not yet endorsed any of the projects submitted through this process. All projects with an MPO RAW score below 45 were given ZERO MPO points.

Highlighted projects are only partially within the MPO and points were assigned based on the percentage set by NCDOT.
