The Craven County Board of Elections held a meeting on November 14, 2011, with the purpose of conducting the State ordered mandatory Sample audit of two precincts, and to review provisional ballots from the November 8, 2011 General Election. Woods called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

A Sample audit team was tasked with doing a hand/eye count for the East Havelock Precinct. The sample audit involved the Commissioner's race with six candidates and write in votes. At approximately 9:30 a.m., the team began the audit. Five of the counts did not match original returns, given voter intent with write in options. At approximately 11:30 a.m., the team had completed the audit.


16 Provisional ballots were presented for review, of those 8 were approved, 0 were partially approved and 8 were not approved.
