SECOND PRIMARY Election Craven County, North Carolina

The registration books closed Friday, April 9, 2010, at 5:00 p.m., from the Primary Election held in Craven County on Tuesday, May 4, 2010. A Second Primary Election, as a result of the May Primary, will be held June 22, 2010, and the registration books will remain closed until after canvass for the June 22, 2010 election.

Eligibility to vote in this election is limited to registered Democrats and Unaffiliated voters that either did not vote, or voted democratic ballot in the May 2010 Primary. Please note the criteria in the following table.

| Pursuant to NCGS 163-111(e), There shall be no registration of voters between the dates of the first and second primaries. Persons whose qualifications to register and vote mature after the day of the first primary and before the day of the second primary may register on the day of the second primary and, when thus registered, shall be entitled to vote in the second primary. The second primary is a continuation of the first primary...-Subject to this provision for registration, the second primary shall be held under the laws, rules, and regulations provided for the first primary. Persons who are registered with the Democratic Party or as an unaffiliated voter by 5 pm on April 9, 2010, shall be eligible to vote in the Democratic Second Primary for US Senate to be held on June 22, 2010, UNLESS the voter executed a non-partisan ballot or participated in the Republican Primary held on May 4, 2010. | | | |

Absentee Voting

Absentee voting is comprised of two methods by which registered voters may cast ballots other than the traditional method of appearing in person and casting a ballot on the day of the election. These methods are mail in absentee and absentee one-stop.

A voter may apply for mailed absentee ballot until 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 15, 2010. The application must be made in person or in writing to the Craven County Board of Elections. The "One-Stop" method can also be used. "One-Stop" voting begins on Thursday, June 3, 2010. The deadline for voting "One-Stop" is 1 p.m. Saturday, June 19, 2010.

The Board of Elections will meet at 5:00 p.m. on the following dates June 8th, 15th, and June 21st, to approve returned absentees. Absentee ballots will be counted on Election Day, June 22nd at 5:00pm in the Board of Elections Office; results will be released at 7:30 p.m. when the polls close.

Election Day Electioneering

In accordance with N.C.G.S. § 163-166.4, please remember there is to be no campaigning within 50 feet of the entrance to the voting place on Election Day. Precinct officials have a difficult job managing voter flow and assuring procedures are followed within the voting enclosure. Unnecessary electioneering within the 50 foot parameter detracts from the effective operations of the polling place and interrupts the election process.

Election Day Assistance to Voters

In accordance with N.C.G.S. § 163-166.8, the following scenarios permit assistance to voters in the polling place on Election Day:

- 1) Near relatives may assist voters at the request of the voter:

- 2) Any person may assist blind, disabled, or illiterate voters, ***ONLY IF REQUESTED BY VOTER.***
- 3) Precinct Election Officials may assist any voter, ***ONLY IF REQUESTED BY VOTER***


