Remarks:

1. Sales tax refunds paid to non-profits and local governments for the first 6 months of FY14 distributions are \$332k more than the refunds paid on the FY13 distributions for the same time period.
2. Miscellaneous revenues are up in FY14 mainly due to the receipt of the County's share of motor vehicle registration tax proceeds from the NC's Eastern Region in the amount of \$1.5 mm.
