PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION

The primary purpose of this position is to report timely, accurate and reliable test results using independent judgment in hematology, microbiology, chemistry, urinalysis, serology, virology, phlebotomy, bacteriological food testing and other miscellaneous tests.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Must have ability to produce and report accurate, reliable and timely test results on clinical specimens in waived, moderate or high complexity tests as defined by CLIA '88. Areas include hematology, microbiology, virology, chemistry, urinalysis, serology and other miscellaneous tests. Must be able to perform phlebotomy on neonatal, pediatric, and adult patients using standard equipment and supplies. Will be required to perform bacteriological analysis of food samples. Must be able to perform all tests according to CLIA, OSHA and/or state mandates.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Associate's degree in medical technology from an appropriately accredited institution or completion of a certified laboratory assistant course in medical technology or a comparable course, and one year of medical laboratory experience; or high school or General Educational Development diploma and three years of medical laboratory experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience preferred.

ADDITIONAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Must perform Quality Control and Quality Assurance on all lab tests, procedures, equipment, media and reagents. Perform preventive maintenance and troubleshooting on all instruments and procedures. Must successfully participate in required Proficiency Testing on all tests. Maintain inventory log. Train students/other health care professionals in procedures. Laboratory Computer System skills/experience required.
