DOVER VFD TRUCK PURCHASE

The Dover VFD is in the process of purchasing a used fire truck from the Town of Southern Pines, for \$30,000. The plan includes combining the financing with the current loan on their 2007 truck, combining the two and extending the loan for two more years. This will put the debt load at approximately \$60,000 total for five years, around \$13000 per year. (this is what is being paid currently).

JULY VETERAN CIVITAN BIOGRAPHY-MEET LEN LONG



Len Long is one of those people you never forget. He has a gleam in his eye that shows you he can be serious, but does not want to take the world too seriously. A Marine for 33 years, Len spent 21 months in Vietnam between 1965 and 1968. As a Mustang, Len moved from the enlisted ranks to become a commissioned officer. He knows both sides of the military chain of command well. In 1971, Len was selected as one of the outstanding Young Men of America. His military ties run deep, and Len is a lifetime member of the Disabled Veterans, a lifetime member of the Vietnam Veterans of America, and a member of the American Legion.

The Marine Corps has taken Len, Dauphne, his wife of 51 years, and their four sons to both coasts, Hawaii, and overseas.

Civitan has been a fairly recent interest for Len. At the urging of Jimmie Shine and Mel Tabler, Len joined our club in September 2000. He was quickly recruited to the Board of Directors and served as Club President four years ago. He has attended three national conventions, worked on the peanuts, Christmas Trees, Paul Dean products, fruitcakes, disabled Scouts, coin boxes, and projects at the Boys and Girls Home. Len personally purchased beds and couches for the Civitan Cottage at the Home.

Two additional loves for Len are his church and the Boy Scouts. Wherever he has lived, Len has been active with both. Just ask a member at St. Andrew Lutheran Church about Len. They will tell you that it would not be the same church without him. Whether it is running the kitchen on Saturday night meals for the neighborhood, teaching Sunday School, or taking inventory as part of the Church's Property Committee, Len always carries out his responsibilities in his own style and always with great enthusiasm.

His entire adult life has been committed to the Scouting movement. This is no small task for someone who was an active duty Marine while he was doing much of it. He has been a scout master and leader in most of the places where he and Dauphne have lived. When asked what achievement made him most proud, Len replied it has been to "be able to prepare youth to replace us, and help them develop character and personal growth, to be ready to lead with Christian values as citizens of the greatest country in the world.."

With all of the traveling he has done, Len considers the trip he took with three of his four sons to the Philippines in 1976 to be the best. He attended an international Scouting jamboree, serving as scoutmaster for 100 American Boy Scouts. As part of that celebration, Len walked 30 miles of the infamous Death March on Bataan Island.

When he is not scouting or working on a Civitan project, Len enjoys his time as a master gardener. He is currently president of the Craven County Master Gardener Volunteer Association.

Len listed Robert E. Lee as his favorite GRAY FOX general – none too surprising for someone born in Richmond, Virginia. Asked about what goal he would still wish to fulfill, in typical Len Long style, he answered: "to [continue to] support and defend the Constitution of the USA and the Republic for which it stands."
