The North Carolina Nature and Historic Preserve Amendment, also known as Amendment 1, was on the ballot in North Carolina on November 5, 2002, as a legislatively referred constitutional amendment. It was approved. The measure allowed property to be accepted into the State Nature and Historic Preserve by an enactment of a bill rather than by a joint resolution
