



CRAVEN COUNTY PROCLAMATION DECLARING STATE OF EMERGENCY (TROPICAL STORM ISAIAS)

Section 1

Tropical Storm Isaias currently threatens the eastern United States coastline, and its predicted impacts on Craven County are significant in nature. The forecasted impacts constitute a public emergency which may render public safety authorities unable to afford adequate protection for lives, safety or property.

Section 2

Pursuant to Chapter 12 of Craven County's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 166A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Article 36A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and as Chairperson of Craven County's Board of Commissioners, I have the authority to declare states of emergency.

Section 3

Therefore, I hereby **DECLARE** that a **STATE OF EMERGENCY** exists in Craven County **effective at 4:00 pm on Sunday, August 2, 2020**. This State of Emergency will *continue until cancelled or rescinded*.

Section 4

All emergency management workers and law enforcement officers are hereby directed to assist in the implementation of this order, subject to Craven County's emergency management plan and subject to the orders of their management or superior officers, as the case may be.
