

Care Coordination for Children

Serves children birth to five years of age who:

- Have long term medical conditions; and/or are dealing with challenging levels of stress; and/or referred by the child's doctor.
- Services include: home visits, screenings, parent education and coordination for additional community services.

Pregnancy Care Management

Serves pregnant women having a "high risk pregnancy" and on Medicaid.

- Services include: home visits, counseling, provide resources, and help coordinate prenatal care.

Our goal is to help pregnant women have a healthy pregnancy and healthy baby.

Women, Infant and Children (WIC)

Serves women and children (birth to 5 years old)

- Provides food vouchers, nutrition counseling, community education and breastfeeding support.

Health Preparedness and Response

- Plans and responds to all hazards that could affect public health.
- Training of employees in the Health Department and partners.



Health Education

- To improve the health and wellbeing of individuals through policies and programs regarding disease prevention, and promoting healthful living.
- Provides individuals with the tools and skills to make healthy choices the easy choice.

Community Services

- Provides HIV expanded testing in jails and communities.

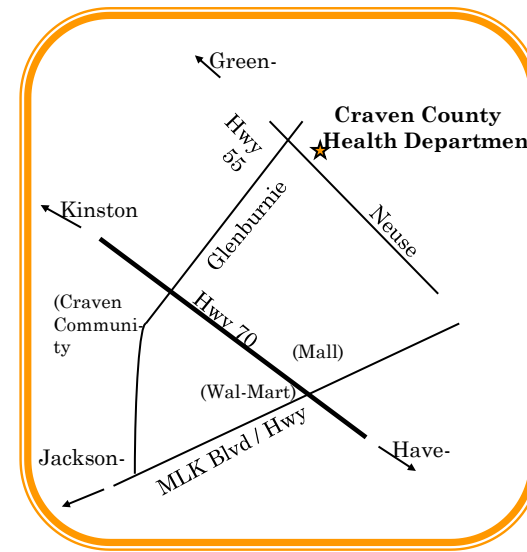

We accept most private insurances, NC Health Choice, Medicare, Medicaid, and other payment options including sliding scale fees with proof of income, and flat fees for most clinical services

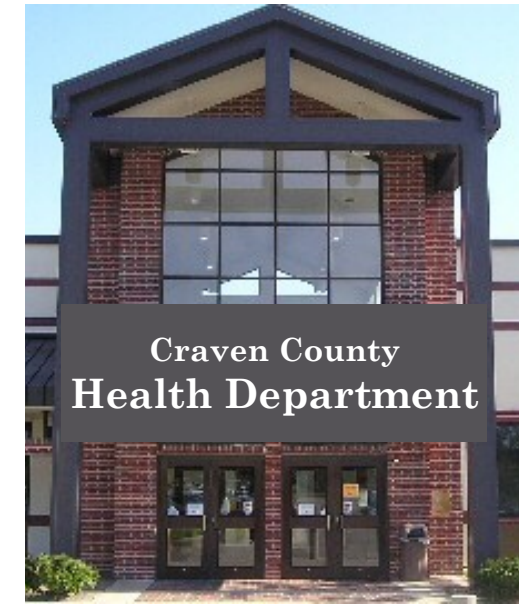
We accept Credit/Debit Cards
