(vote at your assigned precinct from 6:30 am until 7:30 pm)

## Who can register to VOTE?

- ⇒ U.S. Citizen
- ⇒ Live and reside in county for 30 days prior to date of the election where you are registering
- ⇒ Be at least 18 years old, or will be by the date of the General Election
- ⇒ Not be serving a sentence for any felony conviction, including probation, parole, or post-release supervision

- \* DRIVERS LICENSE or VOTER ID (for more options visit our website listed below)
- \* YOU MUST STATE YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

## WAYS TO REGISTER TO VOTE/ UPDATE VOTER REGISTRATION

1. First obtain or access a NC Voter Registration/Update form from Board of Elections office, [www.cravenvote.com](http://www.cravenvote.com) and/or [www.ncsbe.gov](http://www.ncsbe.gov), party offices, libraries, schools, certain government agencies
2. Return completed & signed form in person or by mail.
  - ◆ Same Day Registration during early voting periods (certain rules apply-same day must have ID and proof of residency)

Or register online:

- ◆ Online or in-person at the DMV (link on [www.ncsbe.gov](http://www.ncsbe.gov) and [www.cravenvote.com](http://www.cravenvote.com))

## CHECK YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION

1. Information will be on your mailed **VOTER CARD** once you register. Keep this card for your records. You do not need this card to vote.
2. Check registration status by entering your information into the “Voter Search” also known as the “voter lookup” on **[www.ncsbe.gov](http://www.ncsbe.gov)** or **[www.cravenvote.com](http://www.cravenvote.com)**.

You will need to submit your first and last name. To narrow your search results, you can add more information, such as your year of birth or county, but that is optional. With this tool, you will be able to find publicly available information, including your:

- Voter registration status.
- Election Day polling place.
- Sample ballots for upcoming elections.
- Voting districts.
- Past elections you participated in, called “voter history.”
