

CRAVEN COUNTY ORDER IMPLEMENTING HURRICANE FLORENCE

Section 1

By Proclamation issued at 12:00 pm on September 10, 2018, I declared a state of emergency existing in Craven County. Subsequently by Order issued at 2:00 pm on September 11, 2018, I directed the mandatory evacuation of all persons from all areas of Craven County. Subsequently by order entered on September 13, 2018, I imposed a curfew applying to all unincorporated areas of Craven County.

Section 2

Due to the strength of Hurricane Florence and the impacts presently occurring on Craven County, I have determined that a significant risk to the safety of persons presently within Craven County continues to exist.

Section 3

Pursuant to Chapter 12 of Craven County's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 166A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Article 36A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and as Chairperson of Craven County's Board of Commissioners, I have the authority to impose a curfew applying to all persons present in any part of Craven County outside of an incorporated municipality, city or town, and I have also have the authority to declare and extend states of emergency.

Section 4

Therefore, and pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, I hereby ORDER, DIRECT and IMPOSE a **CURFEW** from 8:00 pm on September 14, 2018 until 8:00 am on September 15, 2018, applying to all persons in all areas of Craven County outside of an incorporated municipality, city or town; provided, this order shall apply within the limits of a municipality upon request by the mayor for same. During the duration of this curfew, any person present on any public property, street, highway, road or right-of-way shall be guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor, pursuant to NCGS sec. 14-288.20A. **EXEMPTED** from this curfew and order are all governmental employees or representatives discharging their official duties.

Furthermore, I hereby **EXTEND** the **STATE OF EMERGENCY** previously declared until 11:59 pm on Sunday, September 16, 2018.

Section 5

Prior proclamations not inconsistent with this order shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6

All emergency management workers and law enforcement officers are hereby directed to assist in the implementation of this order, subject to Craven County's emergency management plan and subject to the orders of their management or superior officers, as the case may be.
