



**CRAVEN COUNTY ORDER
EXTENDING STATE OF EMERGENCY
HURRICANE FLORENCE**

Section 1

By Proclamation issued at 12:00 pm on September 10, 2018, I declared a state of emergency existing in Craven County. Subsequently, I extended the state of emergency until Sunday, September 16, 2018, at 11:59 pm, and I further extended the state of emergency until Friday, September 21, 2018 at 11:59 pm.

Section 2

Due to the continuing impacts of Hurricane Florence on Craven County, I have determined that a significant risk to the safety of persons presently within Craven County continues to exist.

Section 3

Pursuant to Chapter 12 of Craven County's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 166A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Article 36A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and as Chairperson of Craven County's Board of Commissioners, I have the authority to declare and extend states of emergency.

Section 4

Therefore, I hereby **EXTEND** the **STATE OF EMERGENCY** previously declared until 11:59 pm on Monday, October 1, 2018.

Section 5

Prior proclamations not inconsistent with this order shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6

All emergency management workers and law enforcement officers are hereby directed to assist in the implementation of this order, subject to Craven County's emergency management plan and subject to the orders of their management or superior officers, as the case may be.
