Craven County at a Glance

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Florence, Craven County residents and local governments have been approved for nearly **\$259.1 million** in state and federal funds:

- Nearly **\$16.9 million** in state and federal grants have gone to **3,866** homeowners and renters.
- As of Dec. 14, **2,724** flood insurance claims have been filed. An estimated **\$182.2 million** in claims have been paid to date.
- Nearly **\$60 million** in U.S. Small Business Administration low-interest disaster loans have been approved for **1,317** homeowners and businesses.
- FEMA has provided nearly **\$31,000** federal share to help local governments with Hurricane Florence-related expenses.

Individual Assistance

- As of Jan. 8, **8,560** home inspections have been issued. Approximately **99 percent** of home inspections have been completed.
- Transitional Sheltering Assistance is an option using participating hotel/motels to help survivors identify short or long-term housing solutions.
 - Current number of households checked in: **30**
- Craven County has been approved for FEMA Direct Temporary Housing Assistance. Travel trailers and manufactured housing units may be provided for eligible applicants.
 - As of Jan. 8, temporary housing units licensed in: **68**

Public Assistance

- Craven County was approved for assistance to local governments for debris removal and emergency protective measures Sept. 14 and permanent work Oct. 12.
- As of Jan. 8, **21** Requests for Public Assistance were received and **19** approved to date.
- An applicant briefing was held Oct. 8.
