

CERTIFICATE OF CANVASS OF  
THE CRAVEN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
FOR THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOND REFERENDUM  
OF THE  
COUNTY OF CRAVEN, NORTH CAROLINA  
HELD ON THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1992

WE, the undersigned Chairman and Members of the Craven County Board of Elections, DO HEREBY CERTIFY that we met on September 1, 1992, at the hour of 11:00 o'clock a.m., in the Office of the Board of Elections in New Bern, North Carolina, to canvass the returns of the Bond Referendum held in the County of Craven, North Carolina on September 29, 1992, and that the result of such canvass is as follows:

1. The total number of voters who voted "YES" in answer to the question "SHALL the order authorizing \$12,000,000 of bonds, secured by a pledge of the faith and credit of the County of Craven, to pay, together with any other available funds, the actual costs of improving and providing additional facilities for Craven Community College, including constructing additional facilities and renovating and remodeling existing facilities, the acquisition and installation of necessary furnishings, equipment and machinery, and the acquisition of land or rights-in-land therefor, and a tax to be levied for the payment thereof, be approved?" was 2,295. The total number of voters who voted in answer to such question was 6,183.

2. All persons voting in said Bond Referendum were required to use ballots setting forth the question to be voted upon in the form prescribed by the Board of Commissioners of Craven County.

3. Only the persons who had been duly registered were permitted to vote in said Bond Referendum. The total number of persons who were registered and qualified to vote in said Bond Referendum was 36,686.

4. The polls for said Bond Referendum were opened at the polling places in the County, on September 29, 1992, at the

On October 1, 1992, at 11 o'clock a.m., Craven County Board of Elections met and received from the registrars and judges the returns of the Bond Referendum held in said County on September 29, 1992 upon the question of approving \$12,000,000 principal amount of General Obligation Bonds of said County for the benefit of Craven Community College.

After said returns have been canvassed by the County Board of Elections, Walter H. Leake introduced the following resolution which was read:

RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CANVASS OF THE RETURNS OF THE CRAVEN BOND REFERENDUM HELD IN THE COUNTY OF CRAVEN, NORTH CAROLINA ON SEPTEMBER 29, 1992 UPON THE QUESTION OF APPROVING \$12,000,000 COMMUNITY COLLEGE BONDS AND DETERMINING THE RESULTS THEREOF

BE IT RESOLVED by the Craven County Board of Elections:

Section 1. The returns of the Bond Referendum held in Craven County on September 29, 1992 upon the question of approving \$12,000,000 principal amount of General Obligation Bonds of said County for the benefit of Craven Community College having been received from the proper election officers and having been canvassed, this Board has found and determined and does hereby resolve:

(a) That each registrar and judge for said Bond Referendum was duly qualified by law and had taken the necessary

(b) That the election officers had incorporated in their returns not only the number of votes cast for and against the question submitted, but also the number of voters registered and qualified to vote in each precinct in said Bond Referendum.

(c) That at said Bond Referendum there was submitted to the qualified voters of said County the following question:

SHALL the order authorizing \$12,000,000 of bonds, secured by a pledge of the faith and credit of the County of Craven, to pay, together with any other available funds, the capital costs of improving and providing additional facilities for Craven Community College, including constructing additional facilities and renovating and remodeling existing facilities, the acquisition and installation of necessary furnishings, equipment and machinery, and the acquisition of land or rights-in-land required therefor, and a tax to be levied for the payment thereof, be approved?

(d) That no complaints have been made to this Board against the regularity of said Bond Referendum.

(e) That said Bond Referendum and the registration therefor were duly and properly held in accordance with law.

Section 2. The following schedule correctly shows the locations of the several precincts at which said Bond Referendum was held and, as to each precinct, the location of the voting place, the number of voters registered and qualified to vote, the number of votes cast in favor of the question submitted and the number of votes cast against such question; the number of election day transfer ballots cast in favor of such question; and the number of election day transfer ballots cast against such question; the number of absentee ballots cast in favor of such question and the
